Our general English courses run at four levels:

- Elementary
- Pre-Intermediate
- Intermediate
- Upper Intermediate

Each level is designed to run for twelve weeks and uses the Cutting Edge series of text books. These books have been chosen because they come with a wide range of activities

and practice all four language learning skills: Speaking, Listening, Reading and Writing.

You can start your course at the beginning of any week. Every 5 weeks, there will be a progress test. If your progress test indicates you are ready, you can progress to the next level.

Course Focus

Our general English course aims to accomplish two things:

- **To help you make the most of your stay in Australia.** We try to give you the skills you will need for day to day living. This includes the language you will need for social situations, shopping, travel and part time work.
- **To act as a pathway to university and our other courses.** This may mean you want to go on to a vocational course or to take our IELTS preparation or English for Academic Purposes course.

Method

Our General English courses focus on communication. We aim to make classes' student centered. This means that whenever possible you will be using your English.

Each week a topic and new language will be presented by the teacher, you will then have lots of opportunity to discuss the topic and practice the target language.

Assessment

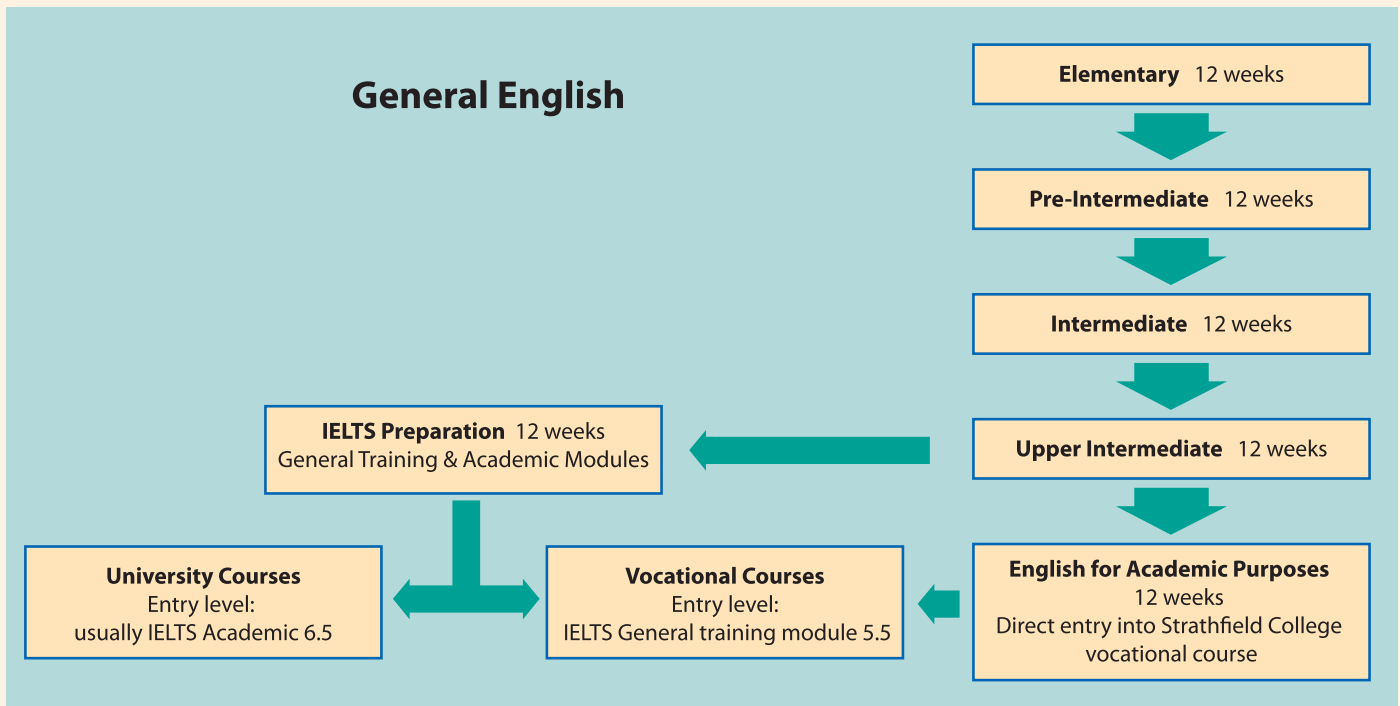
Your level will be tested regularly during the course and when you are ready you will have the opportunity to move to the next level.

At the end of your course you will be awarded a certificate that will give you marks for speaking, listening, reading, writing and attitude. The certificate will also give the level of your course
